MINUTES OF THE FREEHOLD BOROUGH HOUSING AUTHORITY March 6, 2019

Chairman William Cannon called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. in the Administrative Office of the Freehold Borough Housing Authority. The following Commissioners were present: Commissioner William Cannon, Commissioner Ruthann Broxmeyer, Commissioner Erika Woods and Commissioner Stella Mayes (via tele-communication). Also, present were Executive Director Joseph M. Billy, Attorney Peter C. Lucas (via tele-communication), and Sharon Whetzler.

Commissioners that were excused: None

Chairman Cannon read the Open Public Meetings Act Notice, "Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided by the Secretary of the Housing Authority of the Borough of Freehold by preparing a Notice dated <u>December 12, 2018</u>, setting forth the date, time and place of this meeting. Said notice was published in the local newspaper for circulation and posted on the Authority's website.

<u>THE MINUTES OF THE February 6, 2019 MEETING:</u> Commissioner Woods motioned and seconded by Commissioner Broxmeyer to approve the Minutes. The roll call was unanimous and the minutes were approved.

<u>ATTORNEY REPORT:</u> Mr. Lucas reported Judgement was filed and granted against a former tenant who has failed to fulfil their repayment agreement with the Housing Authority.

Mr. Lucas reported that a court date of February 15, 2019 was held in the Monmouth County Landlord/Tenant Division regarding a family resident who is currently behind in their rent. An agreement was made with the resident and the Housing Authority at that time.

Mr. Lucas reported to the Board that it was time to review and renew Mr. Billy, Executive Director contract. At this time, Mr. Lucas inform the Board that the Annual Rider is for a 1-year extension to Mr. Billy's original contract with a hourly \$10.00 pay increase.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:

At this time, Mr. Billy, Executive Director reported on the following topics:

Mr. Billy reported that the Board members received in their package an updated Treasurer report and Vacancy report as of January 31, 2019. Mr.

Billy reported that the Housing Authority finance remain healthy as reported in their package.

Mr. Billy reported that the Housing Authority has 1 vacant unit at the senior location and 2 vacant units at the family site effective January 31, 2019. The Housing Authority continues to notify and interview potential applicants for its vacant units and is accepting applications for it waiting list for seniors 62 years of age and older, and families that would qualify for a 3-bedroom unit.

Mr. Billy asked if there were any questions pertaining to the Housing Authority's bill list.

Mr. Billy informed the Commissioners that the NJNAHRO Conference will be held on May 5th through May 8th at the Hard Rock Casino in Atlantic City. Information will follow once it has been finalized for those who wish to attend.

<u>RESOLUTION #720-19:</u> Commissioner Broxmeyer motioned and seconded by Commissioner Woods to approve the list of bills presented for payment dated March 6, 2019. The roll call was unanimous. The bills were approved for payment.

<u>RESOLUTION #721-19</u>: Commissioner Woods motioned and seconded by Commissioner Broxmeyer to approve the extended the Personal Agreement for Mr. Billy, Executive Director for 1 year. The roll call was unanimous.
